The commemoration of the death of the Blessed Virgin Mary is known as the Assumption because of the tradition that her body did not decay when she died, but that she was raised up body & soul into heaven.

This tradition was present in 6th century ; by the beginning of the twentieth century it was widespread ; & after

consulting the views of bishops all over the world, Pope Pius XII, in 1950, formally & infallibly declared the doctrine of the Assumption to be part of the authentic & ancient doctrine of the universal Church.
