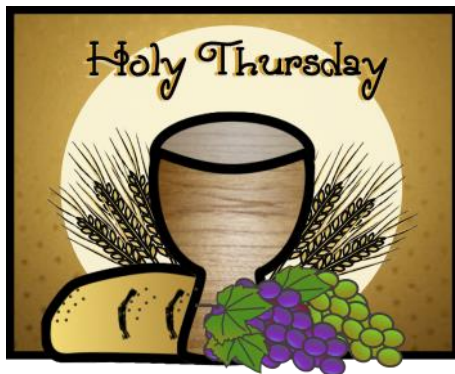

and save us.

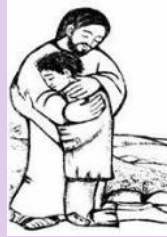


You call me
