Hello from Cath Batey, Mzati & everyone in Kazomba Village, near Mzimba, Northern Malawi....
Everybody sends their love & there are so many fantastic tales to tell from the last year or so....

Cath will be at 11 am Mass this Sunday 3rd November for a quick update of what's happening.

The best news is that the new school is finished & up & running!

Thank you to everybody who has contributed.

We have a little problem though......& we think you can help.

We are victims of our own success!

Our school is about 3 times bigger than the old nursery school & on the day we opened more than 3 times the number of children turned up. We now have 6 teachers (up from 3!) & lots of mouths to feed for breakfast club & if we can afford it, a meal before they go home.

It costs about £1 donation per month to support one little one for a month and £10 per month to fund a teacher for a month.

Based on the gospel for Sunday 3rd November Thirty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time: Mark 12:28-34

"Which is the first of all the commandments?"

This scripture passage is a call each day to listen to God. An affirmation that God should be at the very centre of a person's existence. Christ says that you should love God with all your heart, mind, soul and strength. This is a call to hear from the innermost place of truth.

The next commandment is to love your neighbour as yourself. Namely treat others as you would like to be treated. Particularly the stranger, or those who are underprivileged or disadvantaged.

Therefore, Jesus is summing up the ten commandments of the Old Testament into just these two commandments. Keeping these two commandments is required instead of burnt offerings and sacrifice.

Today that means putting God at the very centre of everything and everyone you encounter. There is no need to barter or grovel for God's favours, he is always with us.
